Challenge – 31 Days of Praying the Promises of God
October 2016

Day 1

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 5:17, *“If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!”*

Prayer Focus: A miracle happened in your spirit the moment you received Jesus. You became the “righteousness of God” (2 Cor. 5:21) in relation to your spirit. All condemnation gone! (Romans 8:1). Your powerlessness and darkness have passed away and now you have authority of Jesus’ Name and the indwelling Spirit of God, which enables you to resist sin, sickness and Satan.

You are enabled to walk victorious over sin and receive understanding of God, His Word and His will. You are translated from the kingdom of darkness into His glorious light! You are enjoyed by God. He delights in you!

Prayer Points:

*Thank the Lord for the transforming power He has done in your spirit

*Ask Holy Spirit to fill you with His Kingdom power to empower you to walk victoriously

*Declare this miraculous power in your life! Speak out the prayer focus as a declaration:
“A miracle has happened in my spirit! I received Jesus and I became the righteousness of God. All condemnation is gone! I will not yield to my “feelings” of condemnation because they are not truth! All powerlessness and darkness in my life is gone! I now walk in the authority of JESUS’ VICTORIOUS NAME to resist sin, sickness and Satan. These do not have a hold on me anymore! I am enabled to walk victorious over sin and I receive understanding of God, His Word and His will. I have been translated from the kingdom of darkness into God’s glorious light! I am enjoyed by God. He delights in me!!!”

Day 2

Scripture: John 15:5, *“I am the Vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in Him, bears much fruit; for without Me, you can do nothing.”*

Prayer Focus: Jesus promises that if we abide in Him, we will bear much fruit for Kingdom purposes. To abide is an action; it is not passive. Abiding is the Greek word, “*meinate*” which means ‘to stay, live, dwell, stay closely connected, settle in’. In abiding, heaven’s culture is imparted to the heart. Saturate your heart, mind, thoughts with the Kingdom! Align your heart to the rule and reign of Jesus. Agree with what He says and does. Abundant, eternal fruit will burst forth! God’s purpose is not that you will do more for Him but that you will choose to be more with Him. Only by abiding can you enjoy the most rewarding friendship with God and experience the greatest abundance for His Glory!

Prayer Points:

*Ask the Holy Spirit to give you a deeper hunger and thirst for the Word of God and His Presence

*Confess: I NEED MORE OF YOU JESUS!

*Confess, “I abide in the Vine, Jesus. I am confident that abundant fruit will come forth as I continue to remain, allowing God’s Kingdom culture to be imparted to my heart & mind.”

Day 3

Scripture: Galatians 6:9, *“Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.”*

Prayer Focus: This is the principle of investment.

Whatever you sow, you will reap. To get the fruit you want, you have to plant the right seed. The character of the seed determines the character of the fruit. The kind of seed sown determines the kind of fruit that will be produced (the life of the plant is in the seed). What you sow today will require a growing season. You will get back much more than you sow, in the harvest season.

Do not grow weary {Greek word, “ekluo” meaning to relax; to faint; to loosen up} while you are waiting for the harvest. Trust this promise~ you will reap what you have sown. God’s timing for it is perfect. Press on. Keep moving. Keep sowing that seed; watering; fertilizing....before the seed bursts through the ground, there is a WHOLE LOT of growth going on under the soil. Trust that the seeds are going deep into the hidden area you do not see. The roots have to be larger than the height of the plant, or it will not be able to hold the weight.

Prayer Points:

*Ask Holy Spirit to endue you with power to not give up or “relax” while you wait for the harvest season

*Ask the Lord to give you an expectant heart, full of hope and joy

*Declare your commitment to the Lord to sow to the spirit, not the flesh (Galatians 5:16). Ask Holy Spirit if there are any seeds rooted in your heart that are sown to the flesh that need to be uprooted.

*Confess this Scripture in your prayer time: “I will not become weary in doing good, for at God’s perfect timing I will reap a harvest. Lord, I thank you in advance for the harvest.”

Day 4

Scripture: Acts 2:17-18, *“In the last days, God says, I will pour out My Spirit on all people. Your sons & daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. Even on My servants, both men and women, I will pour out My Spirit and they will prophesy.”*

Prayer Focus: God promises to pour out His Spirit more and more as we move toward the end of this age. No one is disqualified~ young, old, children, men, women, boys and girls. What will it look like when we begin to experience His

Presence poured out on us in greater measure? Begin to ask God to pour out His Spirit over you; your sons & daughters; your grandchildren; your co-workers; your pastor; your neighbors; teachers; drug addicts; etc.... It is time to stir up the believers in expectation to see visions, dream dreams and to prophesy!

Prayer Points:

Pray, “God pour out Your Spirit on your sons and daughters. That we would prophesy, see visions and dream dreams! Show us Your signs and wonders.”

Day 5

Scripture: Romans 4:20-21, “*Yet he (Abraham) did not waver through unbelief regarding the promise of God but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God, being fully persuaded that God had power to do what He had promised.*” **Prayer Focus:** What promise are you believing God for? Abraham waited a long time for the promise of God to be fulfilled in his life (the promised child, Isaac), but he held onto the promise and did not waver through unbelief or doubt. Stay filled with faith to inherit the promise of God in your life. Have the determined mindset, like Abraham~ give glory to God in the waiting, knowing God is faithful to all His promises.

Prayer Points:

*Ask the Lord to reveal any area of unbelief and confess those areas.

*Agree with the Lord in prayer whatever the promise is that He has given you (whether a word or a Scripture He has given you)

*Make this confession: “I will not waiver through unbelief regarding the promise of God, but I will remain strengthened in my faith. God, I give you glory and thanksgiving. I am fully persuaded that You have the power to do what You have promised.”

Day 6

Scripture: John 15:5, “He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.”

Prayer Focus: Thank You (Holy Spirit)

Prayer Points:

*Recognize the Spirit’s indwelling presence in you simply by thanking Him for it. Pray, “Thank you Holy Spirit, for Your bright presence in me. I love Your presence. Apart from connecting with You, I can do nothing that effectively (supernaturally) renews my love, sustains my zeal for righteousness, and releases revelation and power in my heart.

Day 7

Scripture: Ephesians 1:17, “May give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him...”

Prayer Focus: Release Revelation

Prayer Points:

*Ask (thank) the Spirit to release abundant revelation of God’s heart, word and purposes to you. Pray, “Holy Spirit, release abundant revelation in me”

Day 8

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 12:7, “But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all...”

Prayer Focus: Use me (Holy Spirit)

Prayer Points:

*Ask the Spirit to use you more and more in the spiritual gifts to minister to others. We pray, “Thank you Spirit, for releasing the manifestation of Your gifts and power through me to help others”.

Day 9

Scripture: Ephesians 3:16, "...To be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man..."

Prayer Focus: Strengthen me (Holy Spirit)

Prayer Points:

*Ask the Spirit to strengthen your mind, emotions, and speech with His might. His power is already in us (Gal. 5:22-23) therefore, pray, "Thank you for the presence of Your love, peace, patience, and self-control in me" or "Thank You for warring against my flesh and guarding my speech".

Day 10

Scripture: John 14:26, "The Holy Spirit...will teach you all things..."

Prayer Focus: Teach me (Holy Spirit)

Prayer Points:

*Ask the Spirit to teach you about God's will and ways that He may manifest His leadership in every issue in your life including finances, schedule, circumstances, emotions, physical body (diet, health), relationships, alignment of the people you are responsible for (in the home, office, ministry), future, greatness in God, opportunities with divine appointments, fears, addictions, and shortcomings.

*Ask that He establish God's order in your home, job and ministry. We pray, "Spirit, I love Your will and ways, therefore, manifest Your leadership in me". He will give us new ideas, order our steps and open doors of opportunity for strategic alliances in each area of our life as we ask Him.

Day 11

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 9:10-11, "Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness, while you are enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God."

Prayer Focus: Financial Blessing

Prayer Points:

*Ask the Lord for financial prosperity for your needs (bread) and finances to sow into others and into His kingdom!

*Ask the Lord to help make you wise in the area of finances

*Ask the Lord to help make you a cheerful giver

*Ask the Lord to help you trust Him more in the area of finances

Day 12

Scripture: Luke 6:38, "Give, and you will receive. Your gift will return to you in full—pressed down, shaken together to make room for more, running over, and poured into your lap. The amount you give will determine the amount you get back."

Prayer Focus: Financial Blessing

Prayer Points:

- *Ask the Lord to help you to give and believe His promises for finances!
- *Ask the Lord for wisdom in where to give
- *Ask the Lord to increase and multiple the gifts that you give- both for the people/ministries that you give to and for when it returns to you!

Day 13

Scripture: Psalm 1:1-3, Scripture: Psalm 1:1-3

“Blessed is the man who...delights in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night. He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water...And whatever he does shall prosper”

Prayer Focus: Prosperity in Life (Emotional, Relational, Financial, Vocational, Etc.)

Prayer Points:

- *Ask God to make you one who delights in His Word and in being in a relationship with Him
 - *Ask God to give you grace to meditate, to think about His Word and to engage Him in conversation day and night
 - *Ask the Lord to make you like a tree- stable and mighty planted by His living water
- *Ask the Lord to fulfill His promise to you and make you prosperous in all aspects of life as you walk with Him

Day 14

Scripture: Psalm 16:11, “You will show me the path of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy; at Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.”

Prayer Focus: Joy

Prayer Points:

- *Ask God to show you His path for your life so that you make walk with Him closely
- *Ask God to release joy to your heart as you spend time with Him and as you recognize His presence in your life
- *Ask God to reveal His pleasures to you

Day 15

Scripture: Philippians 4:6-7, “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus”

Prayer Focus: Peace in Difficult Situations

Prayer Points:

- *Ask God to give you grace and the spirit of prayer
- *Ask God to fill you with peace to guard your heart and mind
- *Ask God to give you peace in difficult or anxiety-provoking situations

Day 16

Scripture: Psalm 86:11, "Teach me your way, O Lord, that I may walk in your truth; unite my heart to fear your name."

Prayer Focus:

Fear of God

The Lord promised that He would put His fear into the hearts of His people. He will do this much more as we ask Him to. Therefore, we must ask the Spirit to impart the fear of God into our heart as He unites our heart to His heard and Word. It is far easier to resist sin and compromise when we feel even a small measure of the fear or awe of God in our heart.

Prayer Points:

Father, release the spirit of the fear of God into my heart. Strike my heart with the revelation of Your majesty, that I might live in awe before You. Release Your presence with holy dread that causes my spirit to tremble before Your glorious majesty. Unite my heart to Your heart and Word, and cause me to delight in the fear of God.

Day 17

Scripture: Colossians 1:11, "Being strengthened with all power... so that you may have great endurance and patience."

Prayer Focus:

Endurance

In the New Testament, the words endurance, perseverance, and patience are often interchangeable. All three speak of being faithful in your God-given assignments under pressure without quitting. We must faithfully preserve for decades, and never draw back from our pursuit of the deep things of God's heart. It takes the power of God touching our spirit to keep us from quitting or drawing back.

Prayer Points:

Father, strengthen me with endurance, that I may do Your will with zeal and diligence, and not quit pursuing the deep things of Your heart. Give me strength to follow through in my commitments to You and to fulfill my life and ministry commitments when it is difficult.

Day 18

Scripture: Ephesians 3:17-19, "...that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height – to know the love of Christ..."

Prayer Focus:

Love

It takes the influence of the Holy Spirit for us to love in the way God calls us to. When we ask for our heart to abound in love, we are actually asking for the Holy Spirit to inspire us in four ways.

- First, we are asking for understanding for God's love for us to abound in our heart.
- Second, we are asking the Spirit to tenderize our heart so that we can abound in love for Jesus.

-Third, we ask Him to help us love ourselves by seeing ourselves as God sees us. Many people despise themselves, and this hinders their walk with God.
-Fourth, we ask the Spirit to cause love for others to abound in our heart.

Prayer Points:

Father, pour out Your love into me by the Holy Spirit, that my heart may overflow in love back to You and to others. I also ask that you impart Your love for Jesus into my heart. I ask for grace to love God with all my heart, soul, mind and

strength. Allow me to comprehend Jesus' love for me and to abide in it – stay connected to it. Let me see myself through Your eyes and love who You created me to be.

Day 19

Scripture: Psalm 43:3, "Oh, send out Your light and Your truth! Let them lead me... bring me to Your holy hill."

Prayer Focus:

Light of Glory

On the day of Paul's conversion, he saw Jesus on the road to Damascus in a great light from heaven (Acts 22:6-11). Moses prayed to see God's glory (Ex 33:18). Afterwards, his face shone with the light of glory. Like Moses, we can also ask to encounter the realm of God's glory.

Jesus said that His disciples would see an open heaven in which they would see the angels ascending and descending (John 1:51). Ask the Lord for supernatural encounters that include seeing angels and experiencing His glory and presence in dynamic ways. Ask Him to shine the light of His countenance on your heart.

Prayer Points:

Father, let me see the light of Your glory. Give me Holy Spirit encounters – dreams, visions, manifestations of Your light, fire, and wind – as You gave to Moses, Isaiah, Ezekiel, the disciples on the day of Pentecost.

Day 20

Scripture: Psalm 27:4, "One thing I have desired... that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord."

Prayer Focus:

One Thing

It is essential to consistently spend time before the Lord in His Word. In other words, to be a man or woman of one thing like David, or Mary of Bethany, who sat at Jesus' feet (Luke 10:42).

Set your heart to be a person of one thing. Commit yourself regularly to be a person of one thing and ask the Holy Spirit to help you to not lose this focus. I ask the Lord to show me, to intervene and speak to me, when I start to drift away from this one thing lifestyle. I ask Him to speak to me from Scripture, through dreams, or just by His still, small voice. As I pray this prayer regularly, I am far more sensitized to receiving the Lord's help and correction when I lose my "one thing" focus.

Prayer Points:

Father, I commit to live as person of one thing. Help me to regularly sit at Your feet as Mary of Bethany did. Strengthen me to desire and maintain a lifestyle that has regular times before You in Your Word. When I lose this focus, send Your Word to deliver me.

Day 21

Scripture: 2 Thessalonians 1:11, "...that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness and the work of faith with power."

Prayer Focus:**Worthy**

Walking worthy before the Lord is not the same as seeking to be worthy so as to earn our forgiveness; rather, it is about having a worthy response to God that prepares us to walk in the fullness of our calling, referred to as fulfilling "all... His goodness." Too many believers come up short of what God has invited them to walk in because of their halfhearted choices. Jesus urged us to pray that we may receive grace to walk worthy of this calling, to escape the compromises in the end times, so that we may stand in victory before Jesus (Luke 21:36). Paul prayed that God would sanctify the disciples completely, and that they would walk in such a way as to be preserved blameless, or without compromise, until they met the Lord.

Prayer Points:

Father, strengthen me to walk in faith and obedience that is worthy to escape all compromise and to prepare me for the highest things that You have called me to. Help me to live free of compromise, that I would walk blamelessly in body, soul, and spirit, and be able to stand before you victorious, in full obedience.

Day 22

Scripture: Ephesians 4:29-30, 5:3-4, Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear. And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God... must not even be named among you... let there be no filthiness nor foolish talk nor crude joking, which are out of place..."

Prayer Focus:**Speech**

Speech is a very significant issue in our spiritual lives. When our speech comes under the leadership of the Holy Spirit, our entire inner man will also come under His leadership. Paul exhorted the saints to not speak any corrupt words, nor to grieve the Holy Spirit by filthy or foolish speech. The subject of speech was on David's "prayer list," as he also asked the Lord to help him control the words of his mouth until they were pleasing to God. David purposed that he would not sin with his mouth that the Lord would set a guard over speech.

Prayer Points:

Father, set a guard over my lips and help me to speak only words that are pleasing to You. Free me from defensive, angry, and foolish speech. Keep me from quenching the Spirit with my words. I set my heart not to sin with my speech, that I could sustain unbroken communion with You.

Day 23

Scripture: Matthew 11:29, "Take My yoke... and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart (humble)."

Prayer Focus:

Humility

Jesus called us to learn from Him about walking in humility, or lowliness of heart. He is willing to teach us about this vital subject if we ask Him for understanding. Ask Him to teach you how to walk in humility.

Prayer Points:

Jesus, teach me how to walk in Your yoke of humility and lowliness I set my heart to learn lowliness of heart from You that will transform my attitudes speech, and actions. Give me wisdom on how to carry my heart in humility.

Day 24

Scripture: Ephesians 1:17, "...that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ... may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him."

Prayer Focus:

Insight into Intimacy

The Holy Spirit desires to guide us into truth, to give us insight into His will for every area of our life. He will teach us to walk in agreement with His heart so that we enjoy intimate partnership with Him. He will give us creative wisdom for our money, time, relationships, career, and ministry activities; in the specific ways that we pursue purity and health; and so on.

Prayer Points:

Father, give me insight into Your Word, will, and ways. Give me wisdom about how to walk in intimacy with You in every area of my life, including my finances, schedule, emotions, circumstance, physical body, relationships, my future, fears, addictions, etc. Let me know the secrets of Your heart. What are You thinking and feeling about me?

Day 25

Scripture: Philippians 4:7, "The peace of God... will guard your *hearts* and minds through Jesus Christ."

Prayer Focus:

Peace and Joy

In this verse, *heart* speaks of our emotions. We do not have to live with a heart filled with jealousy, rejection, anxiety, or fear, nor with a mind filled with turmoil, confusion, and indecision. If we actually ask for peace and joy in specific areas of our life, we will receive more peace and joy from the Lord.

Prayer Points:

Father, strengthen my heart with supernatural peace in areas when I feel rejection, fear, and anxiety; strengthen my mind that I may overcome all turmoil, confusion, and indecision.

Day 26

Scripture: Psalm 107:9, *“He satisfies the thirsty and fills the hungry with good things.”*

Prayer Focus: How thirsty are you? How hungry are you? Do you feel the pang of hunger? How desperate are you God? God’s promise is that the hungry and thirsty will be satisfied. The more you hunger for the things of God, the more fulfilled you will become, but in that comes a greater Holy discontent-- the hunger increases and intensifies in the very act of being satisfied! *“As a deer longs for flowing streams, so my soul longs for You, O God. My soul thirsts for God, the living God,”* Psalm 42:1-2.

Prayer Points:

*Ask God to increase your hunger and thirst for Him because God gives according to our hunger.

*Ask God what needs to be rearranged in your life to go after a deeper hunger.

*Pray the words of Psalm 107:9 or Psalm 42:1-2 as your declaration of hunger & desire for more of His Presence in your life.

Day 27

Scripture: Matthew 11:28-30, *“Come to me’, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.”*

Prayer Focus: These are red letter words, the voice of Jesus. He beckons us to come to Him with a promise of REST. Burdened? The Greek word denotes a load that is not normal for an individual to carry. Weary? The Greek word describes the most wearisome kind of labor; striving; working with every fiber in one’s being. When we come to Jesus, we exchange our heaviness for His light, easy yoke which brings rest and refreshment. This rest has the Greek root which is to “pause”.

Taking on a yoke makes the 2 inseparable. A yoke was used to train oxen & horses. A young ox or horse would be yoked to an older animal to learn how to work; a type of training. That’s what Jesus wants for us~ to be yoked to Him.

The message translation for Matthew 11:28-30, *“Are you tired? Worn out? Burned out on religion? Come to Me. Get away with Me and you’ll receive your life. I will show you how to take a real rest. Walk with Me and work with Me~ watch how I do it. Learn the unforced rhythms of grace. I won’t lay anything heavy or ill-fitting on you. Keep company with Me and you’ll learn to live freely and lightly.”*

Prayer Points:

*Thank Jesus for His invitation to “Come to Me....”

*Ask the Lord to reveal any other yokes you have been living under.

*Say YES to Jesus’ invitation to take His yoke upon you. Receive His Promise of rest and refreshment.

Day 28

Scripture: Romans 8:14, *“Those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God,”* & Galatians 3:26, *“You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.”*

Prayer Focus: Your heavenly Father blesses you with true sonship. He wants you to receive it. He wants you to experience the Father-heart of God, rejoicing in His special creation of you, His kind intention toward you, His matchless love for you and His glory revealed in you! The same Spirit of truth bears witness in you of His Spirit of sonship in

you, living in you to possess your birthright as your Father's beloved son. Be blessed with God's exquisite fathering, and receive it as a true son. Know you are His delight. Be blessed to know without a doubt that your Father is extending His favor toward you, assuring you of release into the full rights of true identity.

Prayer Points:

*Confess: I am a son/daughter of God. He loves me. He likes me. He enjoys me.

*Ask your heavenly Father to re-parent you in ways your earthly mother and father may not have been capable of doing and ask Him to heal any heart wounds.

*Confess: I have the best Dad in the whole world!

Day 29

Scripture: Psalm 32:8, *"I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with My loving eye on you."*

Prayer Focus: God's promise is that He will lead us, guide us, teach us, instruct us, and counsel us. We are not left alone. His is "God with us". Do you need direction? Do you need understanding? Insight? This promise is for you! And God's instruction is perfect. He knows the ways of your heart, so He knows how to teach you. God is tender towards you. He delights in you. He does not want you to walk without direction. God does not lose His temper or get angry when you mess up. His loving eye is on you. He sees you in your weakness, He sees your desire to obey and love Him back. He sees the movements of your heart toward Him. God is with you through the process of growing and maturing in Him.

Prayer Points:

*Ask for the counsel of God's Spirit who is alive in you. Invite Him, "Holy Spirit, come guide me in all Truth that I may walk worthy of the Lord."

*Ask the Lord to direct your heart more and more into His love that you will walk in His ways

*Confess this promise, "Thank you God that You instruct, direct and teach me in the way I should go. I do not have to figure it out on my own. Give me a hunger for Your Word and a desire to spend time with You in the secret place, that I may hear Your counsel. Thank you that You are for me. I am Your delight!"

Day 30

Scripture: John 10:3-4, *"He (Jesus) calls His own sheep by name and leads them out...His sheep follow Him because they know His voice."*

Prayer Focus: God loves you and desires to talk to you. He promises that you can hear His voice and He promises that He will talk to you. Jeremiah 33:3 tells us, *"Call to Me and I will answer you and I will show you great and mighty things you do not know."* God's voice comes in many forms. He uses a 'love language' to speak to you in a way you can understand Him best (words, interrupted thoughts, ideas, pictures, video, impressions, senses, spontaneous flow of words, or Scripture). God's voice is kind and gentle, loving, calm. He is not mean, confusing, frightening or forceful. He does not shame or condemn, even when He is correcting. God's voice speaking to you is to draw us into a deeper relationship with Him.

Prayer Points: These prayer points will be a “listening prayer” exercise. Ask, then listen. Pay attention to the way you “hear” the voice of the Lord in your spirit. Do you get a picture? Words? A video playing across your mind? An impression? Idea? Scripture? Etc...

Ask the Lord,

*What is one reason You are pleased with me?

*When You look at me, Jesus, tell me what you see.

*What word or promise in Scripture do You have for me today?

*How I grow in my friendship with You?

Day 31

Scripture: Hebrews 13:8, “*Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.*”

Prayer Focus: This is a promise we can stand on. In a world of change, Jesus remains the same. From ages past to forever, His Name is unchanging! Jesus is the One “who was, who is and who is to come!” (Revelation 1:8). The Name of Jesus is the most powerful name ever known! So, whatever struggles you may be going through, call on the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and allow Him to bring great change and healing into your life. Psalm 102:27 says, “*But You remain the same, and Your years will never end.*”

Prayer Points:

*Pray and invite Jesus into any present circumstance that you need His healing, guidance, direction or wisdom.

*Declare this promise, “Jesus You are the same yesterday, today and forever. I can trust You. You are faithful to every word and promise You have said.
