In abounding hope, anchored by our hope in the name of Jesus, we pray. Amen!



Ephesians 4:4-6 - There is one body and one Spirit, just as also you were called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all who is over all and through all and in all. Hebrews 6:11-12 - And we desire that each one of you demonstrate the same diligence so as to realize the full assurance of hope until the end, so that you will not be sluggish, but imitators of those who through faith and endurance inherit the promises.

Romans 8:25 - But if we hope for what we do not see, with perseverance we wait eagerly for it. Hebrews 10:23 - Let's hold firmly to the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.

Proverbs 24:13-14 - My son, eat honey, for it is good, yes, the honey from the comb is sweet to your taste; Know that wisdom is thus for your soul; If you find it, then there will be a future, And your hope will not be cut off. Romans 15:4 - For whatever was written in earlier times was written for our instruction, so that through perseverance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope. Psalm 25:5 - Lead me in Your truth and teach me, For You are the God of my salvation; For You I wait all the day. **Job** 11:13-18 - Yet if you devote your heart to him and stretch out your hands to him, if you put away the sin that is in your hand and allow no evil to dwell in your tent, then, free of fault, you will lift up your face; you will stand firm and without fear. You will surely forget your trouble, recalling it only as waters gone by. Life will be brighter than noonday, and darkness will become like morning. Psalm 33:20 - We wait in hope for the LORD; he is our help and our shield. Psalm 31:24 - Be strong and let your heart take courage, all you who hope in the LORD. Psalm 33:16-18 - No king is saved by the size of his army; no warrior escapes by his great strength. A horse is a vain hope for deliverance; despite all its great strength it cannot save. But the eyes of the LORD are on those who fear him, on those whose hope is in his unfailing love. Matthew 12:20-21 - A battered reed He will not break off, and a smoldering wick He will not put out, until He leads justice to victory. "And in His name the gentiles will hope."
